THE 2009 BELLA IS BRIGHT AND BEAUTIFUL, MUCH IN THE VEIN OF THE INAUGURAL 2008 VINTAGE. THIS SELECTIVE, TWO-BARREL LOT BALANCES THE DEPTH AND COMPLEXITIES OF THE OLDER 115 DIJON CLONE VINES WITH THE JOYFUL, FRUIT-FILLED EXUBERANCE OF THE YOUNGER DIJON CLONE 667 AND 777 HIGH DENSITY VINES.

THE AROMATIC COMPLEXITIES OF THE WINE OPEN IN THE GLASS TO EXPRESSIONS OF BLACKBERRY, EARTH, WILD STRAWBERRY AND COLA. THE ENLIVENING ATTACK ON THE PALATE FILLS THE MOUTH WITH LAYERS OF SMOKE AND CINNAMON BUILDING ON A BASE OF BLACK CHERRY AND SPICE. THE FINISH IS SMOOTH, FULL AND LINGERS ON THE PALATE.
